DISSOLVABLE SUCCESS STORY

Time saved in the Eagle Ford

Date: June 2018

Shale: Eagle Ford

County: Dimmit County

Well Type: Horizontal

Bottom Hole Temp: 180° F

Plug Count: 81 (between 11 wells)

Casing Size: 5.5"

Casing Weight: 23#

PROBLEM: An operator in dimmit county, texas was facing an extended lateral in which they could not reach the toe of the well with coiled tubing to drill out composite plugs. The operator was looking for a plug that could be set and would dissolve on its own, allowing for production in the toe section without millout.

SOLUTION: Nine recommended the Magnum Vanishing Plug™ because the operator would be able to set plugs and frac past 15,000 feet without the need for intervention before production.

RESULT: All plugs dissolved as planned and time to production was reduced substantially. Based on the success of this well, the customer continued with the Magnum Vanishing Plug™ on 10 more wells.
